Follow these simple guidelines

This year student artists should choose a favorite animal and illustrate how that animal looks when it feels:

- Angry
- Excited
- Sad
- Surprised
- Frustrated
- Afraid
- Or any other emotion

Contestants should submit original artwork in crayon, watercolor, oil, acrylic, finger paint, colored pencil, pen and ink, or collage. All submissions should be 8½" by 11", oriented horizontally (that is, 11" across the top and bottom of the picture, 8½" on the sides). On the back of each piece of art, please print, in pencil, the student's name, age, and telephone number and the title of the artwork submitted.

A panel of graphic artists and psychologists from the Creative Therapy Store staff will judge entries based on visual interest, creative expression, and the age of the student artist. Your student doesn't have to be an accomplished artist to win!

Enter as often as you wish

A separate entry form must accompany each submission. You may make copies of the entry form on the reverse, download additional forms at www.CreativeTherapyStore.com/artcontest, or request them by calling 800-648-8857.

Students between the ages of 6 and 18 are eligible to enter the art contest through a teacher or counselor. (We encourage teachers and counselors to use the art contest as a group project or individual activity. NOTE: All entries must be submitted by a teacher or counselor, acting on the student's behalf.)

Contestants may enter as often as they wish and can win multiple prizes.

Please wrap artwork carefully so that it will arrive in good condition. Entries must be postmarked no later than March 1, 2012. Winners will be notified on April 15, 2012.
